<p><i>Enrollment into a Medicaid health plan will occur when you receive a notice from New York Medicaid CHOICE telling you that you must choose a plan. This is a mandatory program.</i> As of September 2010, mandatory Medicaid managed care enrollment is expanded for the HIV+ population. <p>Newborn Enrollment: newborns are automatically enrolled into the mother's health plan.</p>	<p>Children born to CHP enrollees do not automatically have medical coverage. Pregnant women are also entitled to Medicaid coverage or they can remain with FHP.</p>
<p>If you enroll in a regular Medicaid Managed Care plan you have 3-months to decide if the health plan is right for you. You can change plans any time during the 3-months trial period. After the 3-months, you must stay with your new plan for the next 9 months (lock-in period), unless you have a special reason to transfer.</p>	<p>Transfers to other plans can take place at anytime. There is no 9-month "lock-in" period for Child Health Plus.</p>	<p>3-months trial period plus 9-month "lock-in" period (12 months total enrollment).</p>
<p>Family Planning: Is covered by most plans, or you can go to any Medicaid provider for family planning and reproductive health services without a referral (free access). Fidelis, does not include family planning services in their benefit package. You must get these services by using your Medicaid card.</p>	<p>Family Planning: All Child Health Plus members can get family planning services. You can go to any one of your health plan's providers or to the designated family planning provider (HealthFirst) if you are a member of Fidelis. You do not need a referral from your PCP for family planning.</p>	<p>Family Planning: All Family Health Plus members can get family planning services. If you join a plan that does not cover family planning services, such as Fidelis, you can go to any clinic or doctor that takes Medicaid and that offers these services. You do not need a referral from your PCP for family planning.</p>
<p>Transportation: is a covered benefit for emergency and non-emergency visits.</p>	<p>Transportation: emergency ambulance transportation to a hospital is covered (no air ambulance)</p>	<p>Transportation: is covered for emergency visits only</p>
