| I need help at home after surgery.                  | <ul> <li>You can tell your surgeon you would like homecare services</li> <li>If the surgeon feels this is required, they will submit a request for a nurse to come out and do an assessment following your surgery</li> <li>You may also be eligible for short-term rehab after surgery. Talk to you surgeon about your care needs</li> </ul> |   |
| Can I get help with transportation for surgery?     | <ul> <li>Medicaid pays for medically necessary transportation</li> <li>This usually includes the trip home and sometimes to post op appointments</li> <li>The medical provider needs to set up transportation</li> </ul>  | MAS_transportation information_111819 v2 315-701-7400                                 |
